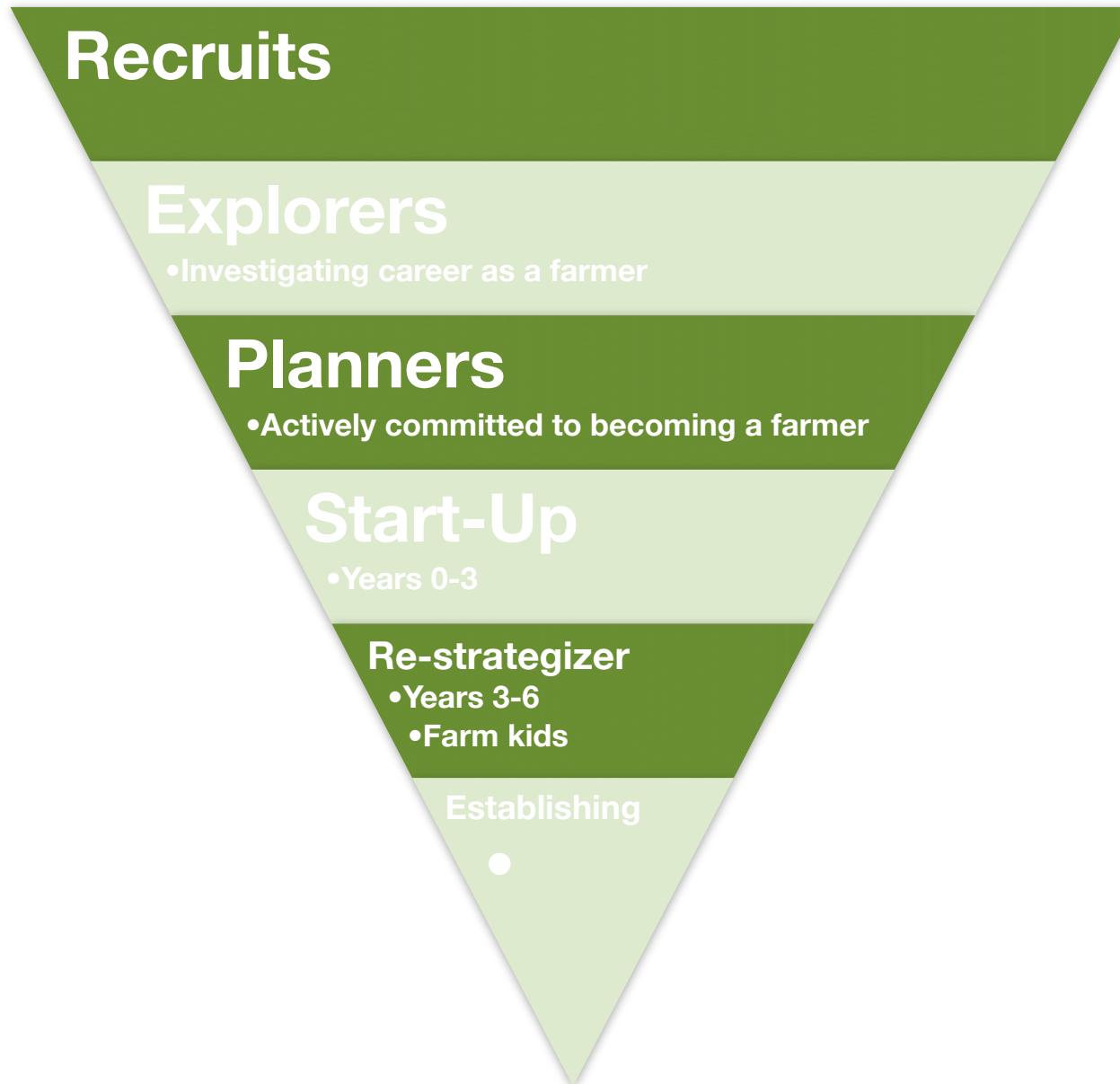

Laying out areas according to permacultural principles, soil fertility first priority, for pastured beef and poultry. Greenhouses under construction summer 2009 for four season harvesting (a la Coleman).
