# Centre locaux de développement (CLD)

- Business start-up helpBusiness plan development support
- Financing

### SUPPORT FOR SELF-EMPLOYMENT MEASURE (SOUTIEN AU TRAVAIL AUTONOME)

- Federally funded 1 year wage subsidy administered by CLD and Employment Quebec (about \$20,000).
- Support to develop your business plan and start up your business.

#### **JEUNES PROMOTEURS**

- Business start-up: up to \$6,000 for starting-up a business
- **Training:** up to \$1,000 for relevant training.

**Prime à établissement** (Establishment Grant)An additional \$20,000 to \$40,000 grant for start-up, expansion or diversification (depending on education level)

•\$10,000 available in the first year.

#### **Loan Garantees**

•Garanteed loans allow farmers to access loans at near residential mortgage rates.

Agrinvest & AgriquebecA savings measure where a percentage of profits may be deposited in an account with contributions matched dollar-for-dollar by the government.

### **Support for young farmers**

- •Covers 50% of new equipment related to production (up to \$10,000).
- •Covers costs associated with agriculture related courses, workshops and conferences necessary to start your business.

Support for Agronomic consulting services 50% to 75% of eligible costs for individual and collective agriculture consulting services.



### Challenges



- •Many new farmers do not come from farm families
- •Land prices are rising faster than inflation



•Recreational farming tends to be developed around urban centres and competes for best land
