
November 1-4, 2018; Montréal, QC

Since the formation of Food Secure Canada in 2001, Assemblies have taken place all over the country. In 2018, Montréal will host our 10th Assembly.






Our National Assembly

Who comes to the Assembly?


- Over 600 attendees from all over Canada


